Matthew 9:9-17 (ESV): "As Jesus passed on from there, he saw a man called Matthew sitting at the tax booth, and he said to him, 'Follow me.' And he rose and followed him. 10 And as Jesus reclined at table in the house, behold, many tax collectors and sinners came and were reclining with MIND. Jesus and his disciples. 11 And when BLOUN. the Pharisees saw this, they said to his disciples, 'Why does your teacher eat with tax collectors and sinners?'..."

"...12 But when he heard it, he said, 'Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick. 13 Go and learn what this means: "I desire mercy, and not sacrifice." For I came not to call the righteous, but sinners.' 14 Then the disciples of John came to him, saying, 'Why do we and the minima. Pharisees fast, but your disciples do not BLOUN. fast?' 15 And Jesus said to them, 'Can the wedding guests mourn as long as the bridegroom is with them?..."

"...The days will come when the bridegroom is taken away from them, and then they will fast. 16 No one puts a piece of unshrunk cloth on an old garment, for the patch tears away from the garment, and a worse tear is made. 17 Neither is new wine put into old wineskins. If it is, the skins burst and MIND. the wine is spilled and the skins are BLOUN. destroyed. But new wine is put into fresh wineskins, and so both are preserved.""






Acts 23:8 (ESV): "For the Sadducees say that there is no resurrection, nor angel, nor spirit, but the Pharisees acknowledge them all."

For you travel across sea and minima. land to make a single proselyte, and BLOUN. when he becomes a proselyte, you make him twice as much a child of hell as yourselves..."

"...Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you tithe mint and dill and cumin, and have neglected the weightier matters of the law: justice and mercy and faithfulness. These you ought to have done, without neglecting the others. 24 You blind guides, straining out a gnat and MIND. swallowing a camel!"


