
















Matthew 27:1-10 (ESV): "When morning came, all the chief priests and the elders of the people took counsel against Jesus to put him to death. ² And they bound him and led him away and delivered him over to Pilate the governor. ³ Then when Judas, his betrayer, saw that Jesus was condemned, he changed his mind and brought back the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests and the elders,...

"...4 saying, 'I have sinned by betraying innocent blood.' They said, 'What is that to us? See to it yourself.' 5 And throwing down the pieces of silver into the temple, he departed, and he went and hanged himself. ⁶ But the chief priests, taking the pieces of silver, said, 'It is not lawful to put them into the treasury, since it is TOTAL COO. blood money.'..."

- "...⁷ So they took counsel and bought with them the potter's field as a burial place for strangers.
- 8 Therefore that field has been called the Field of Blood to this day. ⁹ Then was fulfilled what had been spoken by the prophet Jeremiah, saying, 'And they took the thirty pieces of silver, the price of him on whom a price had been set by some of the sons of Israel, 10 and hey gave them for the potter's

field, as the Lord directed me."




Roman 3:28 (ESV): "For we hold that one is justified by faith apart from works of the law."
