"Love is serving and meeting others' needs from a place of strength and joy, not desperation and approval seeking. As you do this, you'll naturally pull your gaze up from staring at your belly button to seeing the eyes of the loved ones and strangers standing right

in front of you. This is choosing connection. This is the non-anxious life...."

"...Love works. The non-anxious person rejects loneliness. He or she chooses connection, even when it's hard. You choose love over hate, friendship over disconnection, and awkwardness over networking. This is an entry point toward a non-anxious life."
