## QUIBBLING

LUKE 10:38-42

Luke 10:38-42 (ESV): "Now as they went on their way, Jesus entered a village. And a woman named Martha welcomed him into her house. 39 And she had a sister called Mary, who sat at the Lord's feet and listened to his teaching. 40 But Martha was SIBLING distracted with much serving. And she went up to him and MUIBBLING said,..."

"...'Lord, do you not care that my sister has left me to serve alone? Tell her then to help me.' 41 But the Lord answered her, 'Martha, Martha, you are anxious and troubled about many things, 42 but one thing is necessary. Mary has chosen the good SIBLING portion, which will not be taken away from her." OUIBBLING



Mark 6:41: "He also divided up the two fish among them all."

#### MISPLACED CERTAINTY LEADS TO BALD-FACED MAIN ABSURDITY. POINT



"If Wheeler was too stupid to be a bank robber, perhaps he was also too stupid to know that he was too stupid to be a bank robber — that is, his stupidity protected him from an awareness of his own stupidity."
